SOCCER (September – November)

Kindergarten – 8th grade boys and girls. Kindergarten program and 1st grade program is an instructional skills program on Saturdays at Taylor Park (kindergartners) and the Glenwood School Fields (1st graders). 2nd-3rd grade league games are played on Saturdays; practices are various weekday evenings; September through the end of November at Glenwood School. 4th-8th grade league games will be played inter-town with Millburn, Verona, Caldwell and Cedar Grove at Paper Mill/Library Fields and fields in other towns. Games played on weeknights/Saturdays; practices are weeknights at fields in Millburn. Online/mail-in registration through August 12th. Registration Fee is \$75.00.



TACKLE FOOTBALL (August – November)

Travel Teams (tackle) for 6th – 8th graders and Instructional Team (tackle) for 4th – 5th Graders; weeknight and Saturday practices and Sunday league games are at Millburn High School and neighboring towns. Tackle Football Players are placed on teams based on their age, weight, experience and ability to be determined by the coaches at player evaluations. Player Evaluations/Tryouts/Practices begin week of August 15th at Gero Park. Online/mail-in registration May through June 17th. Registration Fee is \$180.00 (\$50.00 is refundable equipment deposit).



FLAG FOOTBALL (September – November)

2nd - 5th graders; weeknight practices and Saturday games at Gero Park Field from September through the end of November. Practices begin in mid-September. Online/mail-in registration through August 12th. Registration Fee is \$75.00.



BASKETBALL CLINIC (September – October)

5th – 8th grade boys and girls. Boys Clinic Monday evenings & Girls Clinic Tuesday evenings at Millburn High School Gym in September and October. Basketball skill development emphasized. Online/mail-in registration through August 12th. Registration Fee is \$55.00.

FIELD HOCKEY (September – November)

5th – 8th graders. Travel team games are played on Sundays in Millburn and other towns; practices are various weekday evenings and Saturdays September through the middle of November. Practice begins week of September 1st at Millburn High School time TBA. Online/mail-in registration through June 3rd. Registration Fee is \$115.00



CHEERLEADING (September – November)

4th – 8th graders. Practices are weeknights at Bauer Community Center, Taylor Park. Cheerleading at football games will be on Sundays from September through end of November at Millburn High School Stadium and neighboring towns. Online/mail-in registration through August 12th. Registration Fee is \$75.00.

WRESTLING (November – March)

1st – 8th graders. 1st – 3rd graders in-town program practice one weeknight per week and Saturday mornings. 4th – 8th graders practice end of November through March. 4th – 8th grader travel team practices are two weeknights per week and on Saturday morning/or afternoon. Practices are at the Millburn High School cafeteria. League Matches are held at Millburn High School and neighboring towns on Tuesdays or Thursdays & Saturdays. Online/mail-in registration October through November 4th. Registration Fee is \$75.00 for in-town program and \$105.00 for travel team.

BASKETBALL - 2nd to 8th GRADE (November – March)

2nd – 8th grade boys and girls. 2nd grade program is instructional skills program on Saturdays, December through February at the Sports Academy. In-town leagues for 3rd – 8th grade play games on Friday evenings and Saturday mornings and afternoons; practices are various weekday evenings December through middle of March at Deerfield, Glenwood, Hartshorn, South Mountain, Wyoming and Middle School gyms. 6th – 8th grade travel team games are played on various weeknights and Saturdays; practices vary from December through middle of March.
