

**TOWNSHIP OF MILLBURN  
ORDINANCE NO. 2469-16  
ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER VII SECTION 7-35.13 ENTITLED “PERMITS—ISSUANCE;  
SCHEDULE OF FEES” AND SECTION 7-35.16 ENTITLED “TERM OF PERMIT” OF THE REVISED  
GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLBURN**

**Statement of Purpose:**        *The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend the existing Code to create a new category of parking permit, and to allow the issuance of three (3) month pro-rated parking permits valid between October 1st and December 31st.*

**WHEREAS,** the current permit regulations were established through the enactment of Chapter VII of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Millburn by the Township Committee of the Township of Millburn; and

**WHEREAS,** a review of the types of permits offered by the Township, and the related fee, has resulted in a recommendation to create a new Summer Intern Permit, which shall be valid from May 1st to September 1st, and be restricted to use of Lot 19; and

**WHEREAS,** that review has also resulted in a recommendation that pro-rated parking permits be permitted for a three (3) month period from October 1st to December 31st.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLBURN IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY,** as follows:

**Section 1.**        Section 7-35.13 “Permits—Issuance; Schedule of Fees” is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

Any Township employee designated by the Business Administrator shall be authorized to issue the permits prescribed by this section and to accept the fees herein prescribed. The following types of permits and schedule of fees are hereby established:

- a. *Commuter Permit.*
  - 1. Annual permit fee.
    - (a).... First car in a household..... \$350.00 to \$560.00
    - (b).... Each additional car in household..... \$450.00 to \$650.00 each
  - 2. Semiannual permit fee.
    - (a).... First car in a household..... \$225.00 to \$425.00
    - (b).... Each additional car in household..... \$275.00 to \$475.00 each
- b. *Business, Whose Full-Time Business or Employment Is in This Township.*
  - 1..... Annual permit fee..... \$230.00 to \$450.00
  - 2..... Semiannual..... \$215.00 to \$415.00

- 3..... Annual transferable permit fee..... \$300.00 to \$500.00
- 4..... Annual remote restricted business permit  
..... (use restricted to Lot 19)..... \$150.00
- c. *Resident's Twenty-Four (24) Hour Permit.*
  - 1..... Annual permit fee..... \$300.00
  - 2..... Semiannual permit fee..... \$200.00
- d. *Transfer Fee.*
  - 1..... Transfer of permit to another vehicle..... \$ 2.00
  - 2..... Transfer penalty (failure to return original sticker upon transfer)... \$20.00
- e. *Summer Intern Permit (May 1<sup>st</sup> – September 1<sup>st</sup>)*
  - 1..... Summer intern permit (use restricted to Lot 19).....\$50.00
- f. For categories where ranges are established herewith, the fee shall be set by resolution of Township Committee.

**Section 2.** Section 7-35.16 “Term of Permit” is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

Annual parking permits shall be for a calendar year only. Semiannual permits shall be for the period of six (6) calendar months, starting on the first of the month for the six (6)-month period for which the permit shall be issued. Pro-rated parking permits shall be permitted for a three (3) month period beginning October 1<sup>st</sup> and ending December 31<sup>st</sup> for each calendar year. (1967 Code § 24-10-16)

**Section 3.** The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and the invalidity of any phrase, clause or part of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remainder of the Ordinance.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as provided by law.
