RECYCLING IS REQUIRED THROUGH AN ADOPTED TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE.

RECYCLABLE ITEMS MUST BE SEPARATED FROM HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE

**Materials not conforming to Township specifications must be disposed of privately.**

### Single Stream Recyclables

Clear, brown or green glass, 1-7 plastics, tin bi-metal and aluminum cans, aluminum foil and aluminum baking pans. Newspaper, brown paper bags, catalogs, chipboard boxes, corrugated boxes, colored paper, computer printout, high grade paper, junk mail, magazines, holiday gift wrap and phonebooks.

**NO PAPER OR HARD COVERED BOOKS!**

**NO STYROFOAM IN BOXES**

Material must be placed in reusable containers not to exceed 30 lbs. in weight. must be tied or placed in brown paper bags, cardboard boxes or placed in reusable containers; corrugated boxes must be flattened and tied. Boxes and bundles can be no longer than 4'. Bundles and containers can weigh no more than 30 pounds.

### What to Bring:

- Automotive Fluids, including motor oil, antifreeze, brake transmission and steering fluids.
- Gasoline
- Household fire extinguishers
- Fluorescent tubes and ballasts
- Mercury/mercury containing products
- Batteries (household and automotive)

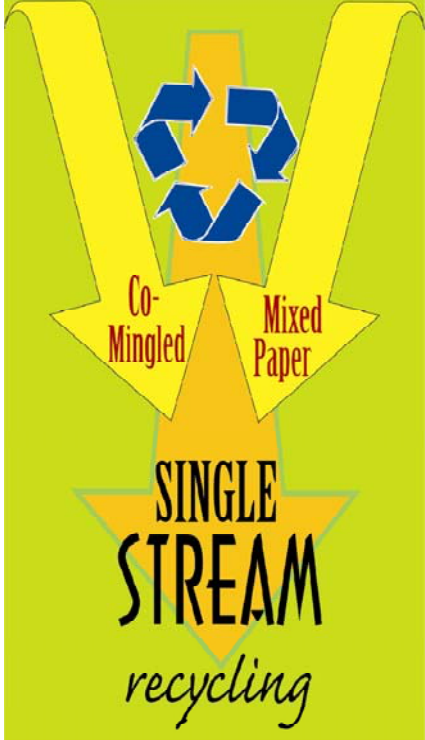
### What **NOT** to Bring:

- Industrial and commercial waste
- Infectious waste
- Radioactive waste
- Asbestos
- Unlabeled or unidentifiable materials
- Medical waste
- Latex Paint
- Highly reactive materials
- Empty containers
- Explosives or ammunition

## Christmas Tree Recycling

**Christmas Trees will be recycled during the month of January.  
Place tree and holiday greens at curb using the following guidelines:**

- Remove all garland, lights, ornaments and tree stand.
- Remove all nails and wire used to secure tree and greens.
- If a tree disposal bag is used, once at the curb remove bag and dispose of it in garbage.
- Leave at curb. Trees and greens will be picked up and recycled.
- Wreaths and garland containing wire will be picked up with your household garbage. Please keep these materials separated from trees to be recycled.



### **NEW E-CYCLING!!!**

The Town Recycling Yard is now accepting electronics for recycling. Items that are accepted include CPUs and other computer peripherals such as printers, keyboards, monitors, scanners, copiers, etc. Cell phones, PDAs, televisions, stereos and other electronics are also included.

# GARBAGE

<p><b><u>Important Things to Remember</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Packaging materials including Styrofoam, plastic bags and bubble wrap must be deposited with your household garbage.</li> <li>-Bulky waste must be separated from your household garbage</li> <li>-Do not place refuse containers at curb before 7:00 P.M. of day preceding collection day.</li> <li>-Remove refuse containers from curb by 7:00 P.M. on collection day</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>VEGETATIVE WASTE</u></b> Curb Collection <b>NO PLASTIC BAGS!!!</b></p> <p>Grass clippings, small quantities of leaves, small tree branches, herbaceous waste and twigs may be placed in open containers at the curb for collection. Open containers must not exceed 30 lbs. Branches and/or brush must not exceed 3 feet in length and 4 inches in diameter and must be tied in bundles not to exceed 30 lbs. Residents are limited to a total of 4 containers or 4 bundles per week. Twigs and branches placed in containers must not protrude beyond the container. Do not place roots, stumps, logs, fence posts, or lumber at the curb. These items will not be picked up. There will be no Vegetative Waste Pickup or Brush Pickup from November 1<sup>st</sup> through February 28<sup>th</sup>, but you may drop off year round.</p> <p>Leaves must be deposited at the Township Yard by Residents only. Brown biodegradable bags are acceptable. All plastic bags must be emptied &amp; removed from the site.</p>	<p><b><u>WHITE GOODS</u></b></p> <p>Large metal appliances, such as air conditioners, stoves, washers, dryers, refrigerators, cast iron plumbing fixtures, and water heaters are picked up by appointment on <b>TUESDAYS ONLY</b>.</p> <p>Call 973-564-7062 to arrange for pickup. Items must be placed at the curb after 7 P.M. the day before; State Law requires all doors and lids be removed from freezers and refrigerators prior to leaving them unattended at curbside.</p>

## **DISPOSAL OF LEFTOVER PAINT**



1. **REDUCE:** Buy only paint you need and omit leftover paint
2. **STORE PAINT CORRECTLY:** Just cover the opening with plastic wrap and replace
3. **LET IT DRY OUT:** Remove the top and put it in an area where it will not get knocked over. It takes awhile but the paint will dry with time.
4. **HELP IT ALONG:** Quicken the drying by adding an absorbent material such as speedy dry, cat litter, or shredded newspaper.
5. **EMPTY OR DRIED OUT:** Paint cans where the paint has been completely used or the paint has thoroughly hardened in the can, can be disposed of at the Township Recycling Yard.
6. **OIL BASED PAINTS AND STAINS:** Essex County Utilities Authority accepts these items on their yearly household hazardous waste collection day. This event usually takes place in early spring.

Reminder: OUR RECYCLING YARD DOES NOT ACCEPT PAINTS, THINNERS, VARNISHES, PESTICIDES, HERBICIDES, CHEMICALS OR GASOLINE. THESE ITEMS ARE ACCEPTED AT THE ESSEX COUNTY FACILITY ON THEIR SPONSORED DATES.

## **Bulky Waste**

### **MATERIALS ACCEPTED**

Indoor and outdoor furniture, outdoor play equipment (concrete must be removed) toys, screens, screen doors (only in small quantities), rugs, mattresses, box springs, television sets, electronic devices, small appliances, paint cans (must be empty or dry), clothing, metal storage sheds (must be disassembled), and tires only (no wheels).

### **MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTED**

Household garbage, chemicals and toxic materials, dirt and rocks, explosives, private business waste, construction material, auto frames and bodies, R.R. ties, demolition material, concrete, tree trunks and stumps, firewood and large branches, wooden fence, chain link or wire fence, outside wooden storage sheds or paint.

Method of disposal for materials not accepted would be through a private collection service. Tree trunks, stumps, and firewood disposal would need to be through a private tree service.

## THE RECYCLING YARD

Important information regarding the materials accepted at the yard and rules related to dropping off bulky waste and recyclables.

**Weekdays, from 8:30 A.M. to 2:30 P.M.**  
**Saturday, 8 A.M. to 12 P.M.**

NO COMMERCIAL LANDSCAPERS ALLOWED IN THE YARD.

**\*No truck or van loads of vegetative waste are permitted in the Public Works Yard.**

Remember the 5 R's:

- Replace
- Refuse
- Reduce
- Reuse
- Recycle

### Yard Rules

1. **NO CLIMBING ON OR INTO RECYCLING BINS**
2. **NO CLIMBING ON OR INTO BULKY WASTE BINS**
3. **NO CLIMBING IN OR RUMMAGING THROUGH THE DISCARD PILE FOR BULKY WASTE**
4. **NO LOITERING**
5. **NO BOX TRUCKS OR TRAILERS OF ANY KIND ALLOWED IN YARD**

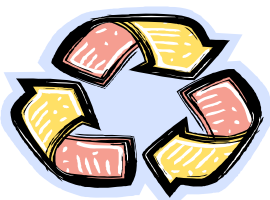
