

## Tours

Millburn Fire Department offers Fire Prevention Tours for Township children ages 2-12 and Township Social Groups. Tours take place in the training room and on the apparatus floor surrounded by fire engines so children can get a sense of a working fire station. We do not schedule fire engines to attend an offsite birthday party. During the tour, firefighters will do a safety talk, covering fire safety. Children and adults are welcome to explore the fire trucks and equipment. Firefighters will be on hand to answer questions.

Each event includes a tour of the fire station, a firefighter gear demo. A firefighter will put on gear and explain how it keeps him safe and the children are taught not to be afraid of firefighters. If it is a nice day outdoors, children may be able to squirt the hose depending on the amount of children attending and time constraints.

The Millburn Fire Department does not supply food or drinks, nor is food permitted in the building. Parking is not permitted on the front ramp. Please park in the rear of the building.

Please remember that although you will be touring the fire station, all firefighters are on duty and subject to leaving on emergency response calls. Should this happen, all visitors must assemble at the rear of the fire station by the fire pole, keeping away from all doors and from exiting apparatus. After trucks have left the premises, you will need to immediately vacate the fire station. For this reason, as well as for your protection, it is necessary to restrict tour group sizes as follows:

Children 2 to 6, no more than 15 per group and one adult per child.

Children 7-12 years of age, no more than 20 per group. At least 1 adult for every 2 children present under the age of 10.

Children over 12 and Adults: No more than 30 per group

Tour times vary in length depending upon the size of the group and type of presentation provided. Generally 45 minutes-1 hour is anticipated.
