MILLBURN OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DECLARATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY / DISASTER

TO ALL CITIZENS AND PERSONS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLBURN, NEW JERSEY; AND TO ALL DEPARTMENTS, DIVISIONS, BUREAUS OF THE TOWNSHIP GOVERNMENT OF MILLBURN, NEW JERSEY.

Emergency Directive 2020-06

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers vested in me by (Chapter 251 of the laws of 1942, as amended and supplemented, N.J.S.A. App A:9-30 et. seq.; N.J.S.A. 40:48-1(6), and ordinances enacted pursuant thereto; N.J.S.A. 2C 33-1 et. seq.; whichever law or laws apply, it is declared that a local Emergency/Disaster exists within the Township of Millburn; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid laws authorize the promulgation of such orders, rules and regulations, as are necessary to meet the various problems which have or may be presented by such an Emergency/Disaster; and

WHEREAS, on May 22nd, 2020 Governor Murphy signed Executive Order 148 that increased the permitted size of outdoor gatherings to twenty-five (25) people; and

WHEREAS, the economic impact on business, including local exercise and fitness businesses, has been significant and ongoing throughout the public health crisis; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Millburn would like to support and provide opportunity to our business community wherever feasible so the following temporary guidelines will be established to allow local exercise and fitness businesses to conduct classes in designated areas of Township parks, public spaces or other Township property as determined by the municipality:

- The fitness or exercise studio must be established in the Township of Millburn and have any license or training required to operate a fitness or exercise business
- The Township of Millburn requires that a certificate of insurance, naming Millburn as additional insured for the activities taking place, be received
- A permit must be obtained from the Township's recreation Department and all scheduling will be conducted through the Recreation Department
- CDC and State of New Jersey guidelines to prevent the spread of COVID-19 must be followed during all classes that are conducted. This will include, but will not be limited to, social distancing of at least six (6) feet all times, no sharing of equipment

and no partner activities such as stretching, spotting or anything that would violate social distancing protocols.

- Classes will be no larger than 25 people, inclusive of any instructors, aids or other professional assistants.


WHEREAS, the Township of Millburn has initially established three (3) locations for such classes, however locations can be altered at any time to provide more space if needed. These spaces are Old Short Hills Park, Taylor Park and the public green space located at the corner of Lackawanna Avenue and Glen Avenue. Available areas will be communicated and controlled by Recreation Department.


WHEREAS, the allowance outlined in this emergency directive are temporary, can be rescinded at any time and will be rescinded when fitness and exercise studios are able to operate within their own space upon an appropriate Executive Order by the Governor; and

WHEREAS, this directive shall rescind the provisions of emergency directive 2020-02 that established a curfew of 8:00PM for curbside delivery and pickup of restaurants in the Township of Millburn. As per this directive there will be no curfew and business shall operate in accordance with applicable local ordinance for hours of operation; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of this declaration can be amended at any time by the issuance of an emergency directive;

NOW THEREFORE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH the aforesaid laws, we do hereby promulgate and declare the following regulations listed below shall be in addition to all other laws of the State of New Jersey and the Township of Millburn;
