

## Township of Millburn Notary Services

The Township of Millburn provides Notary Public services with certain exclusions and restrictions:

- The Notary Publics are not permitted to notarize Wills or Powers of Attorney. These documents need to be notarized by an attorney.
- The office will not witness documents, if witnesses are required you must bring your own.
- Each document requiring the Notary signature shall have a Notary section, see example below.
- You may not sign any documents until you are before the Notary Public and a photo ID is required.
